

Activity 3: Worksheet

Lesson Plan Guidelines

Objective:

What do you want the students to learn?

Example: “Students will learn about America’s democratic government by investigating the three branches of government and their functions.”

Materials or resources needed:

What do you need to teach your lesson?

Example: worksheets, copies of documents to hand out, dictionaries, Internet access, access to a kitchen, etc.

Procedure:

How will you teach your lesson?

Make a step-by-step outline of your introduction to the topic and any activities the students will be involved in.

Example: Activity 1—Discuss the students’ opinions about the government of the U.S.

Activity 2—Pass out worksheets describing the three branches of government.

Activity 3—Divide students in groups to represent the three branches, and ask each group to present a summary of their functions.

Skills used:

Example: listening, speaking, reading, writing

Assessment:

How will you know that students have successfully learned the lesson?

Example: quiz, informal discussion and questions, etc.
